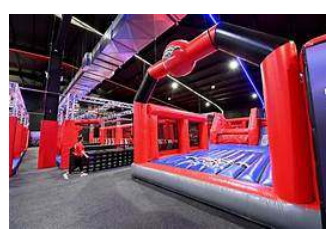
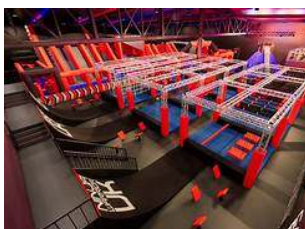


Wizards Trip to Ninja Warrior

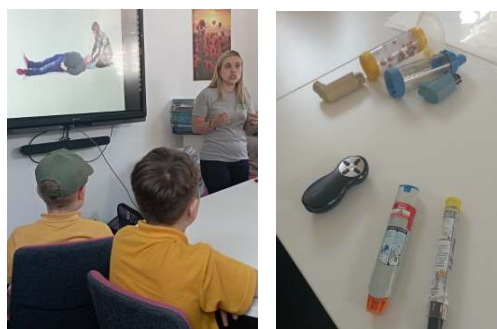
