Ofsted (Section 8) Monitoring Letter

Dear Parents, Carers, Children and friends of Leamore,

As you will undoubtedly have heard, we were visited on the 5th June by an OFSTED inspector to quality assure progress since our last inspection. This was not a grading inspection but a monitoring visit. The aim of this monitoring visit was to assess whether or not school had taken appropriate actions to ensure improvements were made. This includes all aspects of school; Leadership, Governance and Teaching and Learning were all areas probed. As this was a monitoring visit, inspectors can only make one of two judgements about progress – effective or not effective.

It is with enormous pleasure that I write to share the fantastic news that Leamore Primary school has received a very positive monitoring visit report as we were deemed to have made **EFFECTIVE** progress since the last inspection.

I am delighted that Ofsted has recognised all the excellent work that has been going on here since September 2018 and what a 'magical place' the school truly is (yes, one child actually used that phrase when describing how the school had improved!).

The inspector noted that senior leaders and governors are taking effective action to tackle the areas requiring improvement in order for the school to become good.

The report also recognised that the ethos of the school is strong and that low-level behaviours including low level disruption has been eradicated.

We could not have achieved this without your support and I would like to take this opportunity to thank all of you, your fantastic children and our dedicated staff for their hard work and commitment, which has helped to make Leamore such an amazing place to learn, work and succeed.

The report highlights many key strengths of our school.

I am extremely proud of everything that we have been able to achieve here at Leamore and, with your help, as always, I look forward to Leamore continuing on its strong upward trajectory, towards becoming a "good" school. We pledge to continue to help all our pupils fulfil their potential and to inspire the wider community.
